

Compost recipe

LASAGNA LAYERING



1. Bottom layer is made with sticks

This layer improves aeration at the bottom of the compost pile

2. Brown matter

This can include cardboard, dead leaves, newspaper, egg cartons, wood chips and toilet rolls



3. Green matter

This can include vegetable trimmings, prunings, grass clippings, biodegradable tea bags, coffee grinds, weeds and dead flowers

4. Repeat layers 2 & 3!

The layering process helps the compost to heat up, while also providing aeration.



5. Cover the top with a brown layer

This top brown layer allows the contents of the compost to breathe and prevents anaerobic (smelly) pockets from forming. By following these layers, your compost will have a 2:1 ratio of brown to green
