General Business

Sniffer Dog Application – They want to use the outside area. Committee is happy for Sniffer dogs to use the outside area, being the breezeway and verandah, as long as they have Public Liability Insurance and she will pay the same rates as Kate for the outside area.

Switching alterations – Breezeway alterations have been carried out.

Quote to be obtained for the switch for outside lights to be put on the outside of the building.

Oval Condition -Noted email received from council regarding the beetle infestation which will be treated in September.

Council Request – Council have requested to have a signatory on the 355 committee bank account. This was discussed at another meeting and was agreed to have the signature added.

Audio Installation – Quotes obtained and no further action will be taken to go ahead.

Cola Update – Thank you event for the Cola was a success. Signage has been obtained and is being installed.

Defibrillator Update – Grant money hasn't been received for the new Defibrillator. Waiting for installation once the funds have been received.

Little Athletics – Little Athletics have suggested that they may put off the start of their season for 3 – 4 weeks which would mean that their season may clash with the start of the soccer season.

Soccer – The carpark is getting dangerously unsafe as there are so many cars parked for soccer games. There are concerns that there may be an accident or injury because of the amount of traffic parking at the sportsground. It has been suggested to use the area of land across from the Community Centre (Park Street) as an overflow parking area. Also, the two disabled parking spots that are on the Southern end of the existing community centre near the water tank are easily seen. The painting of the sign on the ground may need to be redone. There are also no signs on the road to say where these parking spots are.

Christine to request that council supply signage and roadmaking for this.

Because of the traffic chaos, it has been suggested the soccer use the breezeway toilets for safety.

Christine will send an invitation from the 355 committee to Counsellors requesting they attend a soccer match and see the amount of traffic and to be aware of the concerns raised.

Sportsground floodlights are changing to LED lighting. This is to be done after the Soccer season has finished. An email will be sent to see if this could be done sooner.

Hall Upgrade – Grant funds given by South 32 were insufficient for the projects suggested. Not enough funds are available to do both projects at this time.
