EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The Local Traffic Committee agenda was issued electronically on 15 February 2018 to consider a number of reports for traffic management in the Wollondilly Local Government Area. The agenda papers were also distributed to all Councillors.
- Responses from Committee Members were collated and are reported in the Minutes.
- This report recommends the adoption of the recommendations of the Local Traffic Committee meeting of 21 February 2018.

REPORT

BACKGROUND

The Local Traffic Committee is a Technical Committee of Roads and Maritime Services (RMS). The Committee operates under the authority conferred to Council by the RMS under the *Transport Administration Act 1988*.

Council has been delegated certain powers from the RMS with regard to traffic matters upon its local roads. A condition of this delegation is that Council must take into account the Traffic Committee recommendations.

There are four permanent members of the Traffic Committee, each of whom has a single vote only. The members are representatives of the NSW Police Force, the RMS, the Local State Member of Parliament (for the location of the issue to be voted upon) and a representative of Council.

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RECOMMENDATION

That Council resolve to adopt the Recommendations of the Local Traffic Committee Meeting of 21 February 2018 as follows:

1. **Wollondilly IlluminARTe Festival 2018**

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That Council approve the following subject to the requirements being met for the issue of a permit for “Road Event – Road Closure”:

- That approval is granted for Traffic Management on Friday 4 May 2018 between 9.30am and 2.30pm for the installation of scaffold towers and projectors.
- That approval is granted for the requested road closure of Menangle Street from Colden to Argyle Streets including St Mary McKillop Lane and car park.
- That approval for the road closure be approved from 6.00am till 12.00am (midnight) on Saturday 5 May 2018.
- That approval be granted for local business to have Kerbside Dining on Saturday 5 May 2018 under policy ASS003.
- That approval is granted for closure of Menangle Street West between Argyle Street and Walton Street as required to facilitate safe pedestrian movement at peak times.

2. **Picton ANZAC Day March & Commemoration on Wednesday 25 April 2018**

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That Council approve the following road closures between the hours of 6.30am and 7.00am on Wednesday 25 April 2018 for the staging of “The Picton ANZAC Day March” subject to the requirements being met for the issue of a permit for “Road Event – Road Closure”:

- Menangle Street (West) between Argyle Street and Walton Street.
- Argyle Street between Menangle Street and Memorial Park (south of Downing Street).

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3. **Warragamba ANZAC Day March on Wednesday 25th April 2018**
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That Council approve the closure of Fourteenth Street, Warragamba from Twentieth Street to Weir Road and Civic Centre Circuit between 10.30am to 12.00pm on Wednesday 25 April 2018 for the staging of “The Warragamba ANZAC Day March” subject to the requirements being met for the issue of a permit for “Road Event – Road Closure”.

4. **Picton – Thirlmere – Bargo RSL Sub Branch’s Thirlmere ANZAC Day March & Commemoration on Sunday, 22nd April 2018**
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That Council approve the following road closures between the hours of 1.30pm and 2.15pm on Sunday 22 April 2018 for the staging of “The ANZAC Day March” subject to the requirements being met for the issue of a permit for “Road Event – Road Closure”:

- Oaks Street between Westbourne Ave and Carlton Road.
- Barbour Road between Mason Street and Oaks Street (southbound).
- Westbourne Ave between Oaks Street and North Street.

5. **Macarthur Collegians Cycling Club (MCCC) – Cycling Races – “Razorback Mountain Hill Climb” – Old Razorback Road, Cawdor 2018**
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That permission is granted to use Old Razorback Road, Cawdor from the junctions of Cawdor Road to Mount Hercules Road for Individual Time Trial (ITT) events, “Razorback Mountain Hill Climb” and the necessary road closures on Sunday 18 March 2018 commencing 8.00am and finishing by 11.00am subject to the requirements being met for the issue of a permit for “Road Event – Road Closure”.

6. **Macarthur Collegians Cycling Club (MCCC) – 2018 Cycling Races – Ridge Rd, Oakdale**
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That consent is granted to Macarthur Collegians Cycling Club to use Ridge Road (public road), Oakdale to conduct cycling races for a period up to 31 December 2018 subject to the requirements being met for the issue of a permit for “Road Event – Road Closure” prior to each individual race event.

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7. **Goodlet Street, Thirlmere – new line marking and signage on reconstructed section of road**

That Council endorsed the additional angle parking, the No Stopping zone (R5-400) and the No Parking zone (R5-40) be installed in Goodlet Street, Thirlmere as shown in plan number R2954 sheet number 6.

8. **Bargo - new RFS Station adjacent to Avon Dam Road frontage – Request for “No Parking – Emergency vehicles excepted traffic zone (R5-40)”**

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That Council approve the installation of 45m of “No Parking – Emergency vehicles excepted traffic zone (R5-40)” on western side of Avon Dam Road, Bargo adjacent to the frontage of the new Bargo RFS Station.

9. **Give Way (R1-2) T-intersection control - sign and holding line (TB)**

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That Council note that all T-intersections that do not have complete junction control with an existing holding line and “Give Way” sign be brought before the Local Traffic Committee for approval. This is to be done in the form of a bulk location list as one report.
