Council has been delegated certain powers from the RMS, with regard to traffic matters upon its local roads. A condition of this delegation is that Council must take into account the Traffic Committee recommendations.

There are four permanent members of the Traffic Committee, each of whom has a single vote only. The members are representatives of the NSW Police Force, the RMS, the Local State Member of Parliament (for the location of the issue to be voted upon) and a representative of Council.

### **1.1 "SIMBA DEVELOPMENTS" (426 LOT RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION) AT 41, MARSH ROAD, SILVERDALE—PROPOSED DELINEATION UPGRADE ON MARSH ROAD**

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

1. That Council endorse the implementation of proposed delineation upgrade on Marsh Road, Silverdale; and
2. That the attached plans be approved, with the final detail shown on the engineering plans being approved by Council's Development Engineer.

Jayd Marsh Comments that the line marking arrangement at the intersection with Coveny Street is not a standard layout in terms of the proposed C1 lines with no pavenment arrows and the painted chevrons on approaches to the intersection. Delineation and linemarking should be reviewed and amended to be in accordance with standards.
