Email received from council during meeting, it was read to meeting re Little A's field it involves Night comp having to move back to the western field as previous years due to concerns the new Little A's field turf is not stable enough yet.

With Cricket season starting on 24th September 2022, could the cricket club please ensure that whoever does the draw knows that Tahmoor Sports ground is not available for any cricket matches on Saturday, 3rd December 2022 and Saturday, 7th January 2023, because of Double Obedience Trial and Conformation Show, respectively.

Need for each group to consider how they want to use the new building, we need to work out if we want to have trophy / memorabilia displays if so where,

We need to work out if we want to make bookings for any of the rooms, are we going to try and have administrative space/storage for sports ground committee for example..

This will be best addressed once we have been able to complete a walk through of the new building to get a feel for the size and shape of rooms and likely best use in accordance with location.

Also discussed use of toilets and change rooms. At the moment we haven't labelled any of our change rooms as male / female but home and away. How will that work with up to 800 girls on a Saturday in winter ( Netball and Soccer) and aprox 400 males. We need to consider how we will use and have a plan for consideration.

Once we have a treasurer we need to identify booking and billing system for new building.

Discussed Notice of Motion – Women in Sport, which was moved by Deputy Mayor Cr Deeth and Cr Brandstater, and was resolved by Council at its 26 July, 2022 meeting. We don't believe this will affect us greatly as we already have a balanced committee which will soon be 8 Female and 6 Male members. Discussed that the spirit of the motion is to have gender equality and female representation it is not about having to reduce number of women or increase number of men in our opinion. As such we will be fine
