2. A panel of judges will select the winners of the competition for each age category. The panel of judges will be approved by the General Manager of Wollondilly Shire Council.
3. Wollondilly Shire Councillors, competition organisers, the competition judging panel and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the art competition.
4. Entries must be submitted to the Wollondilly Shire Council Administration Building (62-64 Menangle Street, Picton) by 4pm on Friday the 16th of December 2016.
5. Late entries will not be accepted.
6. Any transport costs associated with the delivery or return of artworks will not be covered by Wollondilly Shire Council.
7. Wollondilly Shire Council is not liable for any damage, loss or theft of any artwork entered in the 'Create Wollondilly 2033' Art Competition. Entrants should organise their own insurance cover.
8. Entrants must arrange to pick up their entries after the conclusion of the competition and/or exhibition. Uncollected artworks will either be donated to local schools, the Wollondilly library or discarded.
9. Entrants in the 'Create Wollondilly 2033' Art Competition give permission for their artworks and artwork description to be reproduced by Wollondilly Shire Council for publications, advertising and promotional purposes.
10. All personal information gathered by Wollondilly Shire Council will be used exclusively for the purposes of running the 'Create Wollondilly 2033' Art Competition.
