Week 1

- Monday activities: Cooking with Rosie: today we will be making Chocolate Birds' Nests. Make an Easter Bonnet and decorate for the parade. Make a tin foil Easter egg shape and decorate with sharpie pens. Design and colour your own Easter Shrink Art.
- Tuesday activities: Excursion to Picton Park for games and a sausage sizzle. Paint and decorate a wooden bunny shape with paints and glitter. Decorate an egg head shape.
- Wednesday activities: Cooking with Cheryl: we are making Easter Biscuits.

 Make a sock bunny using socks, ribbon, eyes and pipe cleaners. Make an Easter basket, paint and decorate. Cut out an Easter egg shape and decorate with marbled shaving cream. Cover one of our trees with paper and paint to decorate.
- Thursday activities: Paint and decorate a 2x4 bunny using paint, hessian, foam, ribbon and pipe cleaners. Make an origami warren of rabbits to decorate your home for Easter. Do an autumn leaf colouring in and painting. We will be having an Easter egg hunt today, bring your Easter bag or basket that you made.

Week 2

- Tuesday activities: Cooking with Rosie: let's make some Chocolate Crackles.

 Make a milk bottle tea light flower to go in our garden for the Illuminarte Festival,
 using a 2 litre milk bottle, paint, glitter, dowel and battery operated candle. Continue
 with our French Knitting to decorate the tree.
- **Wednesday activities:** Make a Pop Stick Lantern using a variety of pop sticks. Make a Tin Lid Owl to hang from a tree or your veranda using a variety of lids and glue. Make stained glass lantern jars using permanent markers to colour.
- Thursday activities: Make soft drink bottle lanterns using the bottom of a 2 litre soft drink bottle, permanent markers, tissue paper and wire to hang. Make a Chinese cardboard lantern using paint, paper, tassels and glitter. Sponge collage cut shapes out of different coloured sponges to make a picture and glue onto cardboard.
- Friday activities: Cooking with Cheryl: make Weetabix Slice. Make a plaster bandage bowl using plaster bandages, bowl, and paint. Make giant pom poms to hang in our trees. Movie day: bring your favourite movie and slippers. We will be having popcorn and hot dogs.
