Health and Safety:-

The lumps/ bubbled surface at netball note court 3 and 10 is getting larger and needs to be repaired, it has been reported as a CRM. We need to check on when it was first reported for warranty purposes.

Sprinkler head on the little A's field and uneven ground

No Smoking/ Vaping sign has been proposed we need to see what council are going to do and then we can add to it with some additional sings we all agree pending what we hear back from council that sports ground to pay for it.

General Business:-

Nyra has spoken to Peter Myers re 25 years of minutes and we will store them once we get the building.

We have been advised by a contractor that the lights not being available for the power change over shouldn't of effected the things running on the old soccer power box as this was only on the netball meter box

The new meters are going to be separate, one for pumps and irrigation, another for netball lights, another for Little A's field lights and one meter for the building usage.

The demountable mens toilets are being left open daily. We believe it is the contractors using them which is not an issue other than the fact that we are paying for the cleaning of them and that they are being left open regularly.
