Minutes of the Previous Meeting:

Business Arising from the Previous Meeting:

 WABKC booking for 8/12 Obedience trials. Joy reported that Bob asked to hold over.

Nicole put motion "That we proceed with the vote as it has been going on for too long" Vote 6 for. (Damian not in attendance at this time)

Nyra read a letter from Dogs NSW stating that no other suitable date was available. Damian gave information – How hard to change due to only a few turf wickets. Our response was to let the association know beforehand, therefore no "change" is needed. This year they came back early to allow for wet weather. Damian wanted noted the procedures manual rule 12 (v) Allocations of the playing fields will be made according to the applications received with Regular Seasonal Hirers given priority. No allocations will be made to clubs who fail to submit an Application Form. (vi) Priority will be given to local Sporting Clubs who have the majority of their members residing in Wollondilly Shire. INFERRED QUERY - WABKC are not a seasonal hirer, are they a sporting club. WABKC as an annual hirer receives the same priority.

Nyra is not in a position now to be coming over and unlocking the gate to let the schools in. If the booking officer worked full time they wouldn't be able to do this. How can this be arranged? How soon does the ground need to be checked because even with Nyra standing there the teachers don't check anything, send a child over to lock the toilets. Last week all taps were left turned on full.

They shouldn't get their bond back. No bond for grounds.

Levy for cleaning should be sent.

Craig said no other grounds have management committees, just through the council and we don't have problems anywhere except here.

Joy said the money collected stays with Tahmoor Sportsground. Queried how much this was – approx. \$12000 per year – this isn't going to do anything, we still need to ask for grants for anything major. The hall floor took 4 years to get done.

GROUND IMPROVEMENTS

NSW Netball recognise Wollondilly as a high need for improvement

The following are the priority items for ground improvements carried over:

<u>Little Athletics</u>: Cover for jump pits.

<u>Kennel Club</u>: Area around canteen and toilets needs to be cleaned up, levelled and surfaced (bitumen or turf, as appropriate). Seating around field.

<u>Netball</u>: Boggy area to be drained so that it can be used for parking. Additional storeroom.

Irrigation of grass courts.

<u>Soccer</u> Barbeque area. Portable grandstand / raised seating. Possible joint venture. <u>Cricket</u>: Movable sight screens. Permanent shaded seating. Move bottom cricket net. More seating.

- Crm for urinal drain change to flat
