

PREPARING TO OPEN WITH A BIG BANG!

Situated in the heart of Picton and part of the Wollondilly Cultural Precinct, the Wollondilly Performing Arts Centre is an elegant, state-of-the-art, flexible format venue with a striking contemporary design that references the lyrebird and water dragon totems of the Dharawal and Gundungurra people.

The auditorium can be configured in different layouts for live performances, corporate events and functions and will host an annual program of high-quality professional performances – everything from orchestras to contemporary dance and music, circus, drama, puppetry and seniors and children's programming. Commercial hirers are already lining up to book in popular comedy, cabaret, music concerts and tribute shows, and the venue will also host local community theatre groups, school presentations, civic events and dance school concerts.


With construction complete, the Performing Arts Centre is now being fitted out with world-class audio, lighting and AV equipment, and commissioning operational systems ready for public access. FLOOD MANAGEMENT

Council is required by the NSW Government to conduct flood risk studies and plans under the NSW Flood Risk Management Manual.

STONEOUARRY CREEK FLOOD RISK MANAGEMENT

We are working through the Stoneguarry Creek Flood Risk Management actions. The latest work involves:

- Updating relevant planning controls to better manage the risks from development in the floodplain
- Investigation of detention basins in the western catchment to see if we can find a way to reduce flooding with this method
- Investigation of a scheme for the voluntary purchase of properties as well as the benefits of removing buildings in the floodway
- Looking at evacuation along Menangle Street and Picton Road during a flood event and what needs to be done to make the route more flood resilient
- · Improving flood warning information availability. We already have a system to monitor flood levels that is reflected on the BOM website for public access. We are also installing a live flood camera (a Live Traffic camera where you can see the creek water levels) on Argyle Street to give another source of remote flood information.

WOLLONDILLY FLOOD STUDY

We collected a large amount of feedback from the recent consultation on draft flood mapping through the Your Say Wollondilly feedback form and interactive map, phone calls, emails, and conversations at our drop-in sessions. We will continue to work through this information and will let you know more later in the year.

LIVE FLOOD CAMERAS ACROSS THE WOLLONDILLY SHIRE

In addition to the Live Flood Camera accessed through NSW Live Traffic on Argyle Street for Stonequarry Creek, we are installing similar cameras in other locations. A camera is being installed on Silverdale Road at Wallacia to monitor flood levels for the Nepean River.

MASSIVE ROADS INVESTMENT CONTINUES

------ IN 2024/25 -----

Roads improvements and repairs remain on top of Council's agenda with a massive roads budget of \$31.5 million for 2024/25, building on the enormous investment in recent years. Our road crews are already out and about working across the Shire this Spring.

On top of this, we will soon be creating a new civil road crew and adding new road surveillance and inspection resources to help us meet the challenge. Road reconstruction, heavy patching and drainage work will continue to be a focus throughout Wollondilly over the next financial year and in the years ahead.

- DRAFTC&MMUNITY SPØRT & RECREATI®N NEEDS STRATEGY PREPARING FOR THE FUTURE

Wollondilly's rapidly growing population is creating both opportunities and challenges for Council when it comes to managing the sport and recreation needs of our community.

Through a comprehensive consultation process, we have developed a Draft Community Sport and Recreation Needs Strategy that addresses the challenges of our changing community profile, urbanisation, and the growing pressures on our existing community sport and recreation infrastructure.

The Draft Strategy proposes investment in new and upgraded facilities across the Shire, from Warragamba through to Yanderra, with a key focus on the growth areas which will house the majority of the Shire's population in the years to come.

For example, the Draft Strategy identifies the need for a Regional Indoor Recreation Centre (with sports courts and an aquatic centre) to be delivered in the Wilton growth area within the next seven years, as well as planning for the future delivery of a District Indoor Recreation Centre in Appin. The implementation plan also includes deliverables such as new sportsgrounds, regional, district and local playgrounds, multi-purpose courts, youth precincts and parks.

DIGITAL INTEGRATION TO THE NSW PLANNING PORTAL

As part of our continuous improvement at Wollondilly, Council's Development Services team has introduced a new digital integration process with the NSW Planning Portal for the recording of Certificate information issued by Private Certifiers. These certificates include Complying Development Certificates, Construction Certificates and Occupation Certificates.

Private Certifiers lodge their Certificates on the NSW Planning Portal for work they have determined within the Wollondilly Shire Council area. Historically, staff have been manually recording the information into Council's systems as required by legislation - a very time-consuming task.

The new API (Application Programming Interface) installed in conjunction with CIBIS International creates the Certificate data record in Council's existing Information Management platforms and automatically saves all the documentation. Staff just need to do some minor checking of data to ensure all the information is recorded correctly.

Since 27 May 2024 over 200 certificates have been processed this way. The time saving of at least two hours per day gives our teams time to work on more in-depth matters – a great outcome for everybody.
